Moving from Limited Company to Umbrella

A PayStream Q&A with Martin Whalley

Depending on your circumstances, when you choose to work as a contractor you have a choice as to how you get paid. Do you go via the agency's payroll? Work through an umbrella company? Set up your own limited company? The nature of the contract you take can also determine what payment options are available to you, as can changes in legislation, so it's not uncommon to see contractors switching between the different options.

In anticipation of the private sector changes being introduced in April 2021, many contractors are finding themselves in a position where they need to move from their limited company to working through an umbrella company.

So we spoke to Martin Whalley, a PayStream accountancy client who made this change, to find out what spurred it on and how he's found the experience.

The impact of IR35

Martin works in the IT sector, delivering a range of solutions to firms and government organisations. He's been involved in this industry for around 30 years,

but roughly six years ago he decided to set up his own limited company, engaging with PayStream to act as accountants for his limited company.

However, his most recent contract required him to work inside IR35, which is what prompted his decision to switch to working through an umbrella company.

This is an option available to limited company contractors who see themselves as being on an inside IR35 contract for a short period of time.

Making the switch
